- ✓ Latest report card and exam certificates (actual exam certificate from summer 2025 must be brought to school on the first day of school in IB1)
- ✓ Personal statement (approx. 500 words about yourself and your motives for applying to the IB Diploma Programme at Hasseris Gymnasium & IB World School)
- ✓ School reference from latest/current school
- ✓ Photocopy of your Danish National Insurance Card ("sygesikringskort"), your Residence
 Permit from the Danish Immigration Authorities or your passport.

Choice of subjects

Instructions:

- Choose six subjects
- Choose at least three and no more than four subjects on Higher Level (HL) and three subjects on Standard Level (SL)
- Choose a minimum of two languages and at least one Language A. If your proficiency in English or Danish does not allow a literature course in any of these languages, contact the IB coordinator. If your first language is Danish, you must choose two subjects from group 1 and do not need to choose a language from group 2.
- History is a mandatory group 3 subject, but you must choose level. If you want an extra group 3 subject, Visual Arts cannot be chosen from group 6.
- Choose one subject from each of the subject groups 4 and 5.
- If you do not choose Visual Arts from group 6, choose another subject from groups 1, 2, 3 or 4.
- If you choose two group 4 subjects, one of them must be Chemistry.
- Placement into Math levels is based on grades from entry exams. Contact the school for more information.
- The school needs a certain number of students to constitute a class, and we cannot guarantee that all your choices can be met. An updated version of courses offered can always be found on the school's webpage.
